Lesson 7: Close of the Commandments

1. What does repent mean?

Symptoms of repentance include: **believing in the gospel, forgiveness, and love.**

2. Is repentance just being sorry?

When Peter realized he betrayed Christ, he **wept bitterly**. He knew he had sinned, but he had faith and **turned to Christ** in his sin. Judas **did not have belief** that he could still be saved and he **hung himself**. Judas was sorry for his sins - so sorry he took his own life. Peter was sorry for his sin as well but his sorrow **turned him from his sin back to Christ.**

3. What is the only way I can deal with the law honestly?

We cannot deal with the law on our own. **Jesus Christ** and **His redemption** is the only way we can deal with the law honestly.

4. What is the difference between sin and unbelief?

We are all sinners - we all mess up and do things imperfectly. **Unbelief** is when we **do not trust** that God will take care of our body and soul.

5. What does it mean to 'keep' the commandments?

To **keep** the commandments means to **guard, protect** and **treasure** the commandments.
