CONFERENCE THEME: BEYOND REASONABLE DOUBT

O Ye of little faith, why did you doubt? It isn't a challenge. It's a call to be the one Jesus pulls from sinking waters. Like Peter. This is where you start to find your identity and belonging. You're not cut off from Christ in this doubt...If you must doubt, doubt boldly. Christ is risen.

DETAILS

- Remember your audience. *You're teaching youth.*
- They can handle challenging teaching and topics.
- Don't you dare skim on the Gospel. Christ and Him Crucified - it's what drips out of all of HT's worship and catechesis.

Your breakaway should address your topic under the light of apologetics.

- How can this topic be defended lovingly but steadfastly?
- How does your topic lend itself to the defense of Christ's death and resurrection being Beyond Reasonable Doubt?
- Explain how you'll teach your topic to youth in your session
- Sessions are 45 minutes, including Q&A at the end. Please be respectful of the time limitations

The submission deadline is **April 21, 2023**. You'll be notified in May if you are selected to teach.
