SUMMARY OF THE JOB

The Higher Things Cantoral Intern works under the supervision of the Cantor and Events Executive to assist the Cantor in assuring all music be planned and executed in good order. This is an annually contracted position with compensation following the work with Higher Things. Active responsibilities are in preparation for and at the conferences. The duties of the Cantor include but are not limited to the following:

IMPORTANT THINGS YOU WILL DO

- Under the supervision of the Cantor, provide assistance to the Worship Coordinator in selecting all hymnody and special music for the Higher Things Conferences.
- Take part in the selection process for conference instrumentalists.
- Assist the Cantor in leading congregational worship in music for up to 1500 people.
- Assist the Cantor in leading and directing a choir and orchestra.

Hours

This position requires approximately 5-10 hours a week, depending on the time of the year, plus your personal practice time. You will need to attend the conference you are playing for.

YOU SHOULD BE...

- A member in good standing of a congregation of The Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod.
- Proficient at organ playing and choral/orchestral direction.
- Experienced with Higher Things Conferences.
- Able to attend the summer conferences.

\$500 annually, as a contract employee. Paid following the conference you work.
