Memory Work

Recite the entire Six Chief Parts of the Catechism.

Brain Break Time!

Chill out with this cross-body exercise

Have kids stand tall and cross one leg in front of the other while pressing the outsides of their feet together. Now have them cross their arms over one another at the wrists. Next they clasp their hands and curl their arms into their chests. Then they can take a few breaths, uncross, and cross the opposite way for a few more breaths.

Instruction/Discussion

What is the Second Commandment?

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

When were you given God's Name?

Read

- Matthew 28:19

You were given God's Name in your Baptism. To misuse God's Name is not so much to use profanities or curse or swear. Names speak of one's character. Misusing God's Name is speaking falsely against Him or His character.

What is God's Name?

Can you think of some names God has given us for Himself?

Give students a minute or two to brainstorm names that they know for God.

Read

- Exodus 3:13-15
- Matthew 1:21-23

God's Name is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Other names He has given us to call Him are: I Am, Jesus, and Immanuel, which means "God with us."

To misuse God's Name is to teach falsely. Why is this so dangerous?

Teaching falsely about God can turn somebody from God. The danger is the difference between salvation and eternal damnation.

If God's Name is a powerful thing to be used for good, how is His giving you His Name a gift?

God's Name is a gift because His Name saves.

What is the Third Commandment?

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

What does this mean?

We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.

What is the gift of the Third Commandment?

God has given us His Word, which makes us holy.

What is the Sabbath Day? What day was it on?

Read

- Genesis 2:1-3
- Deuteronomy 5:12-15

The Sabbath Day is the day we set aside to receive God's gifts—to worship Him. In the Old Testament, the Sabbath Day was Saturday.

Why do we observe the Sabbath on Sunday now?

Read

- Mark 16:1-6

Sunday is the day Christ rose from the dead.


Why do we have a Sabbath Day?

Read

- Mark 2:23-28

The Sabbath Day was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. It is when man receives God's Word and Gifts. The Sabbath is about God's coming down to us, not about our works for Him.

Worship

How can the Sabbath Day be made holy?

Read

- Colossians 2:16-17

The Sabbath Day is made holy by our receiving something holy: Christ's Gifts of Body and Blood, Absolution.

What is church?

Read

- Acts 2:42

Church is the gathering together of people to receive God's Gifts FOR YOU. Body and Blood FOR You. Forgiveness FOR YOU.

We receive God's Word on the Sabbath through Scripture as well as the pastor's sermon. What should be the source and content of all sermons?

Read

- Luke 24:44-47

The source of each sermon should be Scripture, which points us to Jesus.

The content of each sermon should include repentance (Law) and forgiveness of sins (Gospel). The sermon is preached "in Jesus' Name," at His command. It's not just what the pastor wants to say, it's what he is commanded to say on behalf of Christ.

In light of the First Table of the Law, how do we relate to God?

God commands us to trust in Him, and know that He is our salvation. We believe that God is the triune God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We find Him in church and also in His Word.
