1. What does repent mean?

Symptoms of repentance include **believing in the Gospel, forgiveness,** and **love.**

2. Is repentance just being sorry?

When Peter realized he betrayed Christ, he **wept bitterly.** He knew he had sinned, but he had faith and **turned to Christ** in his sin. Judas **did not have belief** that he could still be saved and he **hanged himself.** Judas was sorry for his sins, so sorry he took his own life. Peter was sorry for his sin as well but his sorrow **turned him from his sin back to Christ,** who took the punishment for all of our sins.

3. What is the only way I can deal with the Law honestly?

We cannot deal with the Law on our own. **Jesus Christ** and **His redemption** is the only way we can deal with the Law honestly.

4. What is the difference between sin and unbelief?

We are all sinners, we all mess up and do things imperfectly. **Unbelief** is when we **do not trust** that God will take care of our body and soul.
