#### 1. What does repent mean?

Symptoms of repentance include **believing in the Gospel, forgiveness,** and **love.**

#### 2. Is repentance just being sorry?

When Peter realized he betrayed Christ, he **wept bitterly.** He knew he had sinned, but he had faith and **turned to Christ** in his sin. Judas **did not have belief** that he could still be saved and he **hanged himself.** Judas was sorry for his sins, so sorry he took his own life. Peter was sorry for his sin as well but his sorrow **turned him from his sin back to Christ,** who took the punishment for all of our sins.

#### 3. What is the only way I can deal with the Law honestly?

We cannot deal with the Law on our own. **Jesus Christ** and **His redemption** is the only way we can deal with the Law honestly.

#### 4. What is the difference between sin and unbelief?
